Final details

Join us for our sprint orienteering event in the beautiful grounds of Culford School. This newly-mapped area includes extensive parkland, woodland and a lake, with contrasting complex areas of school buildings, sports facilities, Culford Hall and St Mary's Church. Our thanks to the school for the use of the grounds.

Entry is on-the-day, with start times from 10:30 to 12:00.

Courses close at 12:45. Electronic timing will be used (SI cards may be hired)

Entry Fees: Seniors: £4.00 Juniors (under 21): £1.00 Groups: same as senior rate (extra maps £1)
Hire of SI Card: £0.50 (£30 replacement cost if lost)

Courses: Short 1.2Km Medium 1.7Km Long A: 2.6Km Long B: 2.6Km
(corresponding to official sprint courses 5/6, 3/4 & 1/2 respectively)

Each individual or group entrant may try 2 courses in any combination. Children under the age of 12 may complete the Short course individually but will need to be accompanied by an adult for the medium/long courses because of traffic on site. Please ensure that you visit the Download station after each run so that your times are saved - once you start your second run the data on the SI card will be wiped! It also means that we know you have finished safely.

Map: Scale 1:5000, 2016, prepared to ISOM 2007 & printed on plain paper. Waterproof covers will be supplied if necessary.

Safety: Care is needed when crossing the central road & car park access on the school site as there may be slow-moving traffic. Children may need to be accompanied (see above). As this is a sprint event in open terrain, shorts may be worn.

Basics: The main school entrance is on the B1106 in the centre of the village of Culford. Parking will be by the main school building & will be signed from the entrance. The Start & Finish will both be adjacent to the car park.

The Sports Centre café and toilets are open to the public. The café closes at 13:00.

Dogs are not be allowed on the courses or playing fields but may be walked on the estate [public roads & waymarked footpaths](#).

As British Orienteering is one of the partners in the [McCain "Dare to Do It"](#) promotion, their 2-for-1 vouchers may be used at this event.
