Welcome to the Compass Sport Cup and Trophy Regional Heat organised by EAOA and hosted by SUFFOC in a section of Kings Forest.

Terrain

The area was last used for orienteering in 2016. Parts of the forest were thinned in the following years, but the forest is now back in excellent condition with a lot of good clear runnable terrain, and some areas of intricate vegetation detail. The area does not have any significant climb and is substantially flat. Our thanks to Forestry England for enabling us to use this forest.

Directions

Take the B1106 either from Bury St Edmunds (south) or Elveden (north). Parking is on Ride 201 west of B1106 and will be signed.



New to Orienteering:

Whilst competing in the Compass Sport Cup and Trophy is restricted to EAOA club members, there are three non-competitive courses at this event open to those not competing for their clubs or those new to the sport. These are the light green, yellow and white courses (see course list). You can register for these courses on RaceSignUp or entry on the day is possible, however map availability will be limited.

Once you arrive at the event, if you have any queries or require any explanation about courses, electronic punching, or orienteering techniques please speak to the Event Helper in the Registration tent.

Courses and Maps:

This event uses SPORTident timing equipment. Dibbers (SI-Cards) are available for hire from the desk at the Registration tent. SIAC Contactless Punching will be enabled but please dib the start and finish controls. All courses use pre-printed waterproof maps which are issued at the Start. Control description sheets will be in the start lanes; they are also printed on course maps. White and Yellow courses use text control descriptions. All other

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Insurance: Competitors who are NOT members of British Orienteering will only be covered by the organisation's public liability insurance for a maximum of three orienteering events: after that they will need to become members for the insurance cover to continue.

courses (Light Green and all competitive courses courses) use IOF symbols. The map conforms to ISOM 2017-2 symbols. Map legend can be viewed on a sample map available at registration and will be visible on all A3 sized course maps, but A4 size maps may not carry a full legend.

Members of clubs who enter an appropriate course for their age class by the cut-off date of 4 February on either RaceSignUp or through their club captain will be able to compete for their club. See the rules here

Start Times

These will be allocated according to the Compass Sport Rules and will be published on the Race Sign Up webpage [https://racesignup.co.uk/site/event.php?eventid=3851] within the week before the event. Any changes to start times must be arranged via your club captain and will be at the organiser's discretion. There will be no changes to start times on the day of the event. Please arrive at the start ready for call-up at -4 minutes. If you miss your start you may have to wait some time for the next available start for your club.

There will be no allocated start times for the non-competitive courses; White, Yellow and Light Green.

Start/Finish:

The **Start** and **Finish** are located adjacent to the car park and assembly. It will be a punching start and finish with all other controls SIAC enabled. **All courses close at 14.30. All competitors finishing before the last starter has started will need to place their map in the club bag provided when they finish. Please do not show your course to anyone who has not already completed their course.**

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IMPORTANT COURSE & SAFETY NOTES:

- One major track running roughly N to NNW on the western edge of the competition terrain is marked as out of bounds by purple crosses. Do not cross or run along this track as it is used by fast moving vehicles including motor-bikes.
- Please be aware of, and respect, other forest users including walkers, dogwalkers, cyclists & horse-riders.
- All competitors MUST report to the Download tent even if you have not completed
 the whole course so that we are aware you have returned safely. Courses close at
 14.30, so please return immediately to download if you are still out on the course
 at this time.
- Please wash your hands after your run to guard against infection from grazing animals, & check for, & remove, any ticks you may have inadvertently picked up from the undergrowth.
- You are advised to carry a WHISTLE to summon help in case of emergency.
- Full leg cover is compulsory, & long sleeves, and/or waterproofs, may be advisable on the day

Toilets: Are adjacent to the parking area along ride 201 near the parking.

Keys may be deposited in a box, & confidential <u>medical details</u> (in sealed envelopes, for use in case of emergency) may be left with the event team at Registration. All items will later be transferred to the Download tent for collection.

Dogs are allowed on courses.

First Aid: A First Aid box is available in the Download tent. Nearest A & E is West Suffolk Hospital, Hardwick Lane, Bury St Edmunds, IP33 2QZ (Tel. 01284 713000). Should you need A & E please let an official know before you leave the event.
