

## Suffolk Orienteering Club Tunstall Forest: Barnes and The Birches EAL, Regional Sunday 1st December 2024



Access to the event is via Forest Road FR22 on B1078 2 ½ miles south of Tunstall village. Park as directed on side of FR22 Nearest Post Code IP12 2AP Grid TM399527 what3words economies.winter.windmills

**Terrain**: Barnes Carr and The Birches is the SE portion of Tunstall Forest, in the East Suffolk Sandlings. This area has not been used for orienteering since 2006 and has been newly mapped for this event. It adjoins the Tunstall Forest (Viking) area and the Brown course will extend a little into that area. All other courses will be entirely on newly mapped terrain. The area has more interesting terrain than most Forestry England plantations in E Anglia with a variety of water and relief features and some nice areas of deciduous woodland. The water features are currently mostly dry but won't be if we have significant rainfall before the event.

**Courses and Maps:** White through to Brown, plus Light and Short Green will be available. This event uses Sport Ident E-Punching equipment. All control units will be mixed traditional punching ie dibbing and contactless apart from the start and finish which will be 'punching 'only. Dibbers (E-Cards) are available for hire from the desk at the Registration tent.

This event is an East Anglian League event. Please enter the right course for your age class. More information about the League on East Anglian Orienteering Assocaition web site.

Maps 1:10,000, 5m contours, updated 2024, A4 size. All courses use pre-printed waterproof maps which will be issued at the Start. Control description sheets will be in the start lanes; they are also printed on maps. White, Yellow and Orange courses use narrative control descriptions; Light Green and above courses use IOF symbols.

- If lost head west to B1078. There is a path which runs parallel to the road.
